The subjects of foreign citizens' entry into our country through the land, air and sea border gates and the exit of our citizens from our country were evaluated in line with the positive developments in the fight against Corona virus in the Presidential Cabinet, which was held under the presidency of our President on 09.06.2020.

In this context;

1. Other provisions of our reference Circulars issued by our Ministry in the process of combating the Covid-19 outbreak and regulating the entry/exit of Turkish citizens and foreign citizens to/from our country by air, land and sea were repealed except provisions for passenger entry/exit through Iranian land border gates.

2. The process of air travel planning will be managed in coordination with the Ministries of Health, Foreign Affairs, Transport and Infrastructure. (Estimated Flight Starting Table)

3. Health check will be done to all Turkish citizens and foreign citizens who enter our country. PCR tests will be carried out free of charge in cases of symptoms and needs during health check, and the procedures and principles regarding this process will be determined by the Ministry of Health.

Within the framework mentioned above, entry/exit to our Country will be carried out on condition that the measures determined/to be determined especially by our Ministry, Ministry of Health, Ministry of Transport and Infrastructure and related public institutions and organizations are followed.

I kindly request and submit to be informed and to take necessary action about careful follow-up of the issue by governors and border local authorities, ensuring cooperation and coordination among the agencies in charge, and avoiding any malfunction in practice.
