

Procedure for sailing yachts entering Aruba for cruising Tourism.

Applicability:

Sailing yachts and pleasure vessels entering Aruba for Cruising Tourism.
Implementation date: 1 November 2020



Process:

- A. Vessel shall only proceed to Aruba after having made a reservation with a authorized Marina
- B. Vessels shall only enter Port after approval from the Aruba Ports Authority Control Tower. Prior to issuing an approval the APA Control Tower shall verify if the vessel has a reservation with an authorized Marina.
- C. Only vessels pre-registered with an authorized Martina will be authorized.
- D. The vessel shall arrive in the port of Barcadera. Upon arrival all vessel occupants shall undergo a medical symptom screening and a COVID-19 PCR Test before customs/immigration clearance. This shall be arranged logistically through the APA Control Tower. The fee shall be paid to the authorized Marina at the moment of pre-registration. The authorized Marina shall ensure to transfer the payment to the Medical Entity performing the Medical Screening and COVID-19 PCR Test.
- E. Vessel and all occupants shall go in quarantine upon arrival in Aruba (on anchor at a spot assigned by the authorized Marina) until test results are known and negative.

Conditions:

- A. Only Varadero Marina and Renaissance Marina are authorized Marinas.
- B. The authorized Marina is responsible to enforce the quarantine period.
- C. The APA Control Tower shall keep a record of all authorizations issued.
- D. The authorized Marina shall keep a record of all vessels, including but not limited to the date of entry, and date of departure of any occupant.
- E. The authorized Marina shall inform the vessel of the existing procedure at the moment of pre-registration.
- F. Only a medical entity authorized by the DVG shall conduct the medical symptom screening and the COVID-19 PCR Test
- G. This procedure is subject to change at any time due to COVID-19 developments.
